We have provided a unique Home Learning Code for your child to log in at home: Enter the text code.



Open the Seesaw App on your child's tablet: laptops and computers.



The 3 main areas of the Seesaw platform are the *Journal*, *Activities* and *Inbox* tabs.

Journal	The Journal is an area which children can use to share learning which has taken place outside of school.	Journal
Activities	This is an area where teachers post new learning activities.	Activities
Inbox	Teachers will post whole class and individual messages directly to children via the inbox tab.	Inbox
